

Student Exchange Agreement

concluded the following agreement on the date stated at the end of this document:

1. Student tuition for the exchange student from either school will be free of charge.
2. Travel expenses will be paid by the exchange student.
3. Living expenses will be paid by the exchange student.
4. Host institution will arrange the accommodation for the exchange student.
5. Faculty of Fine Arts (FFA) at Brno University of Technology will offer the subject “Atelier” taught in the English language (see the Appendix 1). Other subjects are only taught in Czech.
6. The exchange student studying at Asagaya will be enrolled in the Advanced Studies Department. Asagaya will offer classes in the English language in the fields of painting, sculpture, video & film, photography, printmaking and digital animation. For painting and sculpture, the student will work in the designated classrooms, and for other fields the student will work in the respective studios. (see Appendix 2)
7. Both Asagaya and FFA will offer the exchange students assistance and guidance by a study administration officer in the English language.
8. This agreement will be updated every five years.

- Photography studio: Facilities for monochrome, color and digital photography
